From the President:

Auction Pricing report. Austin Healey Pricing is the talk of Classic Motorsports Magazine's May issue. (Yes, it is out already and it is not yet April). RM Auctions reported a 1954 BN1 rated at a condition 2 sold for \$51,700 and states; "Strong price indicates a trend starting" for 100's. A 1967 Mark III BJ8 sold for \$49,500. "A nice, show quality restoration." It looks like this market may be correcting, well bought." A 1962 (not identified if tri-carb) sold for \$44,000. "Another # 2 car for a bargain, definitely a price correction." Barrett-Jackson sold 11 big Healeys including the top rated # 1 condition BJ8 bringing \$79,200. "The trend toward softer prices for Healey 3000s continued, with a pair selling for \$66,000 and \$70,400 apiece." Personally, this still sounds high.

Most people have already heard about the Wind Storm blowing down the tent at the Russo and Steele Scottsdale auction. Jim Frakes, Ron Francis and Melanie Haskell helped Bob install the gearbox back into the tri-carb. Before buttoning it up, thought it would be good to take a test drive. Unfortunately, the starter didn't spin when the push button was pressed. Just the clicking of the solenoid. Time to plug in the trickle charger. Couple days later the battery's charged, but still no rotation. Hook the cable up to the starter and away she goes. Back it off the lift and the brakes are rather soft. Back on the lift to bleed them. Have also fitted K&N filters and breather. Should have changed the oil last fall, but was thinking that I would change the oil pan gaskets. But the jack was using the pan to hold the engine in place with the gearbox out.

Jim Frakes, Ron Francis, Steve Martin and Bob Haskell helped Jim Switzer pull the engine and gearbox out of the B so Jim could replace the gearbox input shaft seal. Jim's going to have the cylinder head rebuilt as one of the exhaust valves is sticking.

Jim Frake's 100 is home and Ron and Jim have installed the trunk kit and fixed a couple of problems. Interior is next...
