## Delegates meeting:

Jim Richmond says hi to everyone.

Approved the budget for 2010. Last dues increase was in 1998. There will not be an increase this year. The magazine is 42-46 pages (all color) with good content. National is able to approve extra things like bringing people from England for events. Membership is down 170 members from Nov 2008 to Nov 2009. Total members are 3228 with 19 complementary members.

At the meeting, each club gave reports about club activities and financial status. We are above average for money.

Healey Marque is controlling costs and is ~\$6000 under budget. They are saving money by changing printers. \$110,000 budget for the magazine is the largest part of the budget. Sales of the ads generate ~\$23,000.

~\$8K goes for insurance. There have been very few claims. Administration costs are low.

Most membership renewals for Cincy and Central Indiana will be on-line.

There was a lot of discussion about Conclave. No club wanted to do the 2011 event. National AHC will put on the event in Colorado Springs. Bluegrass is doing the funkhana. Gary Brierton is Rally Master. John May and Carl Brown are co-chairs.

Members who are going to the event can take on tasks. We need to pick out tasks in the next few weeks. The July 4<sup>th</sup> car show may be at the Air force Academy. The hotel is the Crown Plaza Hotel on north side of Colorado Springs. Dinner/awards banquet will be BBQ at the Flying W Ranch. We will need to decide on group event in next 30-60 days.

Conclave 2012 will be in Louisville on June 15<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>. The Bluegrass Austin Healey Club expects to have help from surrounding clubs. Bluegrass did the sock hop for our Conclave. They will be asking for help from our club.

At the Halloween Party, the club decided to have a joint event next year. Ohio Valley will host September Roundup at the Manchester Inn on September 17-18, 2010. Dec. 5<sup>th</sup> Jim and Jo Switzer and Jim Frakes will go to Richmond and have a discussion about the event. The host club keeps the profit. Other clubs will help with the event. The idea is to give groups a break and get more group involvement. Miami Valley and Ohio Valley clubs have around ~40 members each. There are nice roads in Ohio and new venues.

We'll need to think about alternative ways to make money in off years.

Jim Switzer asked if the club would like to host a delegates meeting.

Found that the lip of the input shaft seal was partially torn and rolled over. A new seal has been installed and Bob is thinking about reworking the center shift housing for a reverse light switch.

Ron and Bob helped Jim Frakes sort out the problem with the starter and flywheel for the 100. Looks like a different flywheel's required.

Work is continuing on the Gilham's BJ8. The air conditioner installation has started with the compressor and alternator set in place. The dash has been removed to fit the ducts and the evaporator. The front axles and steering are slowly going back together.
