Frakes' Tech Session Report

A very lively group showed up at Jim Frakes Warehouse to start hanging parts back on Jim's 66 Olde English White Healey. It is not just Olde English White anymore, the area below the swage line is now Porsche Red!

Ron Francis came about 3:00 and helped remove the four fenders, which were only fastened on with tie wraps and a couple of Bolts. Wrapping them carefully in moving blankets and shelving them out of the way was quite a task.

Soon others arrived and eager to find an assignment. Dick Storr's captained a team tackling the installation of the rear axle housing, radius arm assembly, preparing for the new springs and shock absorbers. They were added the next day.

Ron Francis tackled the interior insulation using Dynamat extreme to cover the interior of the firewall. Gotta keep that heat out! Bob Haskell worked on the wiring, followed by some work on the front suspension. Peter VanHorn, meanwhile, added small, but necessary parts to the front end including the steering idler and radiator brackets. Bruce Gilham modified the Moss Firewall Boards where required to fit, and prepared them to paint with white metal primer. Two coats of primer were added later and three coats of Clear Urethane over that. That should keep them a little cleaner looking (for a while). Others who participated or critiqued included Craig Rice, Mike Ford, Roy Bowman and Special Guest Doug Frakes, in for the Holiday.

Pizza, Chips and drinks were served and lots of conversation about Healey or what ever any one had in mind.

Summary of 2015 Delegates Meeting by Dick Storrs

Purpose of Meeting:

Modify By-Laws as needed for clarity, uniformity, and changing time/needs
Approve expenditures, and approve next year's budget.
Approve necessary future plans for meetings (ie. Conclave).

Key Themes discussed: *Focused toward more meaningful and increased participation in club events.*

- Improve communication between the National and Local Club, and between the Local Club and it's current members and potential members.
- Converting from old technology to more useful new technology.
 - Digitizing AHCA records
 - Improved internet communication
 - Club Web Page – Resources are available national to implement
 - Use Facebook – Inexpensive, Ease of Use, Ease of access, Easy to format.
- Attract new members
- Facebook
 - Easy to “search”.
 - Shares information/pictures about your participation.
 - Free advertising about club events, and national events.

- Sharing the Healey experience
 - Give Healey rides to kids, sick kids, kids without Healeys at a Healey event.
 - Attracting young people – rides, adds, “Sprite” give-away, Associate membership

Conclave:

- 2015 Conclave netted about \$30,000 in profit that was shared by AHCA and AHSTC. About \$ 7500 went to National AHCA and the same to the New England Club, who co-sponsored the event with the AHSTC.
- 2016 Conclave will be in Cincinnati June 12 – 17. We should have good turn out.
- 2017 Conclave – location has yet to be determined.
- New Conclave Ideas - encourage smaller clubs to host
 - Clubs with unique skills in one Conclave activity work with another local club
 - Training
 - Doing the activity during Conclave
 - Shared management of Conclave (ie. *ENCLAVE*)
 - A resource center available to blueprint Conclave, facilitating an easier hosting experience for the local club.

2016 National Officers: same as 2015

Notable Actions:

- The club president will be a members of AHCA
- Associate Membership status: under 25; no voting privileges; can attend in all activities; receives the magazine “Healey Marque”; pays \$25 national dues.
- The 2016 proposed Budget is disbursements of \$185,950 on revenues of \$ 188,475 with additional cash on hand of \$100,000+.
- Dues for National will remain at \$50 per year.
- The “Ann Wisdom Riley – Pat Moss Driving Award (for women only) will be awarded to the woman/women earning the highest points in Conclave driving events.

NOTES (etc.):

- 17 of the 49 local AHCA clubs do not currently participate in the annual fall delegates meeting and steps were discussed as to how to approach them, to determine why, and how we could get them to come.
- Leroy and Sue Joppa, long members of AHCA and particularly supportive of the “NASTY BOY” segment of the club, died this past year. With their heirs having no interest in the majority of Healey items in their estate, they have approached AHCA to donate that in which they have no interest. Those holding these items are making them available to AHCA members through and auction/raffle (probably at Conclave 2016). The proceeds will be given to charities that Sue and Leroy supported.
- Watch the “Presidents” column in the “Healey Marque”, as Fred Dabney (the pres.) will remark on the items: Club President and Associate Membership.
- The Manitoba Club celebrated their 25th club anniversary by publishing a book of memories, written by each member and with pictures and articles about past club activities.
- The 2016 Delegates meeting will be held in Indianapolis.

Special Note: This has to do with the heritage you share with past members of Central Indiana AHCA. There are two date relating to local clubs in AHCA: date of formation and date of sanction (entrance to AHCA). Our club shares these dates with the Carolinas Club (Charlotte) and we are both the 7th in formation and the 3rd to be sanctioned in August of 1976. Further, Central Indiana currently has the 17th largest membership in AHCA.
